<p>Description of the Institution / Collection (max. 1,000 characters)</p>	<p>Scott & White is an academic, research and treatment hospital with over 650 beds plus many regional clinics and treatment facilities. It is a large regional medical center with over 7500 employees that treat thousands of patients from central Texas. Historically, it has been a center for the surgical treatment of cancer where many innovative techniques and types of surgical equipment were developed. Today, besides being a full treatment facility and level 1 trauma center, it continues to be a leader in the treatment of cancer, using all the latest modalities. Scott & White is also a center for research and development of drugs targeted for cancer treatment.</p> <p>Ken and Margaret Phillips made the Scott & White moulage collection between 1934 and 1955. The married couple worked as a team in preparing the moulages, both were initially trained as medical illustrators before learning the moulage process. The current collection is what remains of more than 3000 moulages that were made by the Phillips and consists of 1200 to 1300 mostly pathological surgical specimens. The collection is displayed in the Scott & White Department of Anatomic</p>

	Pathology and is available for viewing by interested individuals or groups by appointment during regular business hours.
